### The position

We are looking for a **Policy Intern** to reinforce our team on **Sustainable Finance and Carbon Markets**, topics which are critical for unlocking the investment required for the transition. The implementation and review of the **EU Taxonomy Regulation**, the **Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD)**, the **Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence Directive (CSDDD)**, and the **Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation (SFDR)**, alongside the ongoing evolution of the **EU Emissions Trading System (ETS)** will be key priorities for our association in the coming months.

### What you will do/learn to do

- Support Eurogas' policy and advocacy work on sustainable finance and EU carbon markets
- Draft position papers, briefings, consultation responses and internal notes on EU legislative and regulatory initiatives
- Monitor, track, analyse the developments/implications of EU sustainable finance/carbon markets policies
- Collaborate with Eurogas members, EU institutions, external stakeholders and partner organisations
- Support and join Eurogas delegations in meetings with policymakers, events and stakeholder coalitions
